ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Female or Female-identifying High School Senior pursuing a career in STEM (favoring Technology)
- Attended the in-class GiveTeens20 presentation either at school or during one of the make-up sessions (April 18, 2020 or April 25, 2020 at 10am)
- Utilized the GT20 2-step method (Know Yourself & Learn about Careers)

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

(Please make sure that all items are completed before the application packet is submitted. Each item submitted with the application packet (i.e. “Applicant Information, Letters of Reference, Personal Statement) should be clearly labeled

- Applicant Information Form - Make sure your name is properly spelled the way you want it to appear in all public distribution
- Two (2) Letters of Reference –
One (1) from a teacher, counselor, or community leader
and
One (1) from the Academic Instructor who hosted the GT20 presentation
(If you attend the April 18th or 25th make-up session, provide a 2nd letter from another teacher, counselor or community leader.
- Printed copy of applicant’s online Assessment Result Reports through <https://www.onetcenter.org/IP.html#web-based>
Print “**Your Interest Results**” page, and “**Interest Profiler**” page with listed careers.
- Proof of GPA - Demonstrate academic performance with a Senior Year (or cumulative) GPA of at least 2.3 on a 4.0 scale and be in good academic standing
- Personal Statement – Regarding the GT20 “Know Yourself and Learn” method and how this unlocked the door to your career direction. **The personal statement is preferred, but not mandatory, in video format**
- Details of school/training curriculum, registration information, equipment/supply requirements, etc. (Basically, what are the Scholarship funds paying for?)
